**By the time you read this news letter the DAA will already have joined the NFSA.**



Why, well the main reason is insurance. The Environment Agency has as a condition to giving the DAA permission to use the shingle movers road they has insisted that all fishermen must have third party insurance, to this end we have joined forthwith.

As a association we support the NFSA and it's aims and many of us are already personal members. The cost of membership till December 31st 2001 will be paid for out of the association's funds.

From January the 1st 2002 the DAA will require members to take up individual membership of the NFSA and we enclose a leaflet laying out the benefits.

## **The Plan for 2001 / 2002 winter season.**

To allow us to use the concrete shingle movers road we will have to install a security lock. There will be two padlocks welded at each end of the same chain, one will be painted red and this will be the property of the environment agency for their use only. The other padlock will be painted blue and will be under DAA control. Anybody wishing to use the road will have to sign for a numbered security key available from Phil Tapp (01797 362934) or Seagull Fishing Tackle (01797 366837) and returned when finished fishing. The road will be available from 1730 Friday evening to 0600 Monday morning. To join the DAA for 2002 will cost you £1 (for administration fees). But you will also have to be a member (Individual) of the NFSA for insurance purposes. Any member who causes a problem to the DAA will lose their right to get a key.
